1. SCOPE OF SERVICES, DELIVERABLES. The Fitchburg Housing Authority (FHA) seeks per the requirements of procurement outlined under Chapter 30B of the General Laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts annual fire alarm system tests, maintenance and repairs as needed at the following locations:

- 2. **AWARDING AUTHORITY:** The FHA, a public body organized under the general laws of Massachusetts is the Awarding Authority and its Board of Commissioners shall approve by a board motion and written contract the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.
- 3. **CONTRACT PERIOD:** The contract period shall be for three (3) years beginning January 1st, 2021 and terminating on December 31st, 2023.
- 4. LOWEST RESPONSIVE & ELIGIBLE BIDDER & STATE PREVAILING WAGE RATES APPLICATION: The contractor offering the lowest price that is the most responsive to the bid requirements shall be awarded the contract (M.G.L. c.149 §44A(2(B)) and prevailing wage rates shall *ONLY* apply to the repair of alarm systems and *NOT* for testing per (M.G.L. c. 149 §26 to 27H inclusive.)

- 5. **CONTRACT TYPE:** All contracts awarded by the FHA will be firm fixed price for the annual fire alarm testing portion of the contract and an indefinite quantity for any unforeseen repairs and emergency calls that may arise during the contract period.
- 6. MINIMUM QUALITY REQUIREMENTS: The successful bidder must meet the following criteria at a minimum or the bid will be deemed non-responsive and rejected on that premise:
 - A. Contractor must have five (5) years minimum experience providing the services outlined in the scope of work
 - B. Contractor must have 24-Hour Seven Days a week answering service and ability to respond to emergency calls for service after normal business hours with response times within ninety (90) minutes of notification of the emergency.
 - C. The Contractor shall be one whose business routinely conducts fire alarm testing and repair and the selected Contractor shall be one in which they can furnish an adequate labor force to provide 24-hour service, 365 days per year.
 - D. Contractor's technicians shall possess either a Massachusetts Class C Systems Contractor license or a Massachusetts Class D Systems technician license.
 - E. Contractor must adhere to all applicable federal and Massachusetts labor laws and regulations and safety requirements including those regarding Worker's Compensation, and applicable OSHA approved safety and health training.
 - F. Contractor must have the ability to communicate with the FHA on a timely basis via telephone, email and fax and be able to submit written reports regarding inspection and work performed.

Contractor staff working at FHA locations must adhere to COVID-19 working protocols regarding social distancing and wearing of masks and other appropriate PPEs.

7. **DETAILED SCOPE OF SERVICES:** As noted in Section 1 of this IFB the following is a more detailed scope of services for the locations noted:

A. TESTING

The testing and inspection of the fire alarm systems shall include the following:

- All control panel operations
- All system smoke detectors
- All audible devices
- All pull stations
- All heat detectors
- Standby battery power
- Replacement of fire panel back-up batteries per manufacturers recommendations
- All zones for supervision
- All remote annunciators
- All sprinkler flow and tamper switches
- Proper alarm transmission to Fitchburg Fire Department
- Cleaning all devices

The testing of systems shall be done with the coordination of the FHA and will be conducted during normal business hours. The contractor shall be responsible for providing the FFD with 24-hour notification of any such testing and other required entities. All smoke detectors to be activated by UL listed smoke generating machines. Each test will be conducted by activating such devices and per the professional standards for alarm testing as set forth by current NFPA 72 National Fire Alarm Code and NFPA 101 Life Safety Code for each location.

B. ON-CALL MAINTENANCE & REPAIR REQUESTS/QUOTES

On call maintenance and repair requests and quotes will adhere to the following conditions:

- Additional services beyond testing will be on an "on-call" basis when conditions warrant including emergency situations.
- All requests to make repairs will be in writing and include a detailed quotation to include estimate of hours, parts and materials and total cost and the time of completion. Such

- requests shall be sent to the Executive Director, Deputy Director and other identified FHA employees by email.
- The contractor shall be responsible for cleaning up immediately any materials or debris they have caused due to any testing and/or repairs
- The contractor shall bear the costs they incur in the preparation and production of any repair quotes/estimates

The FHA reserves the right to assign any repair work covered under this contract to its employees and/or to an outside contractor at its sole discretion. The intent will be to honor most if not all repairs to the contractor. However, there may be instances in which the contractor is not equipped to perform such work — or cannot do it timely — and/or the FHA deems it appropriate to consider such work as a capital project and seeks funds from its modernization funds which could trigger the requirement for a separate bid process.

C. REPORTS

Reports – including for emergencies, testing, inspection and repairs from the contractor to the FHA will adhere to the following conditions:

- Detailed device information such as make, model, type, and location.
- Number of each device tested per type. Simply stating "all devices' shall not be sufficient. It is required that the actual number of each device tested be listed.
- If it is determined that alarm systems have failed the contractor MUST notify the FHA in writing in addition to contacting the FHA immediately when such situation occurs.

Proposals for repairs must include costs and listing of any other secondary sub contractors that the general contractor deems necessary. All reports shall be numbered listing the year first followed by the report number for that year example: 2021-001 would indicate that this would be the first report for calendar year 2021. While the contractor shall attach its reports to an invoice, the reports themselves shall be sent independently to a previously provided list of FHA officials as soon as such reported is generated, so the awarding authority can respond as soon as possible to such reports.

8. INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS: The successful bidder must provide minim coverage with respect to the operations performed by any employee, Subcontractor, or supplier:

Bodily Injury: \$1,000,000.00 Per Occurrence

Property Damage: \$2,000,000.00 General Aggregate

Products & Completed Operations \$1,000,000.00 Aggregate

Fire Damage: \$1,000,000.00

Personal & Advertising Injury: \$1,000,000.00 Per Occurrence

Umbrella Coverage: \$1,000,000.00 Per Occurrence

Other standard DHCD contract insurance requirements shall also apply.

- 9. CONTRACTUAL RELATIONSHIP INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR. While so performing the services under this Agreement, the FHA and the Contractor agree, understand and recognize that pursuant to §148B of chapter 149 of the General Laws, Contractor is: (1) free from control and direction in connection with the performance of the service, both under this Agreement and in fact; and (2) the service is performed outside the usual course of the business of the FHA; and, (3) the Contractor is customarily engaged in an independently established trade, occupation, profession or business of the same nature as that involved in the execution of the services required by this Agreement. Contractor further acknowledges that it is solely responsible for payment of any and all income taxes, FICA, withholdings, unemployment insurance, or other taxes due and owing any governmental entity whatsoever as a result of this Agreement.
- 10. AWARDING & REJECTION OF BIDS: The FHA reserves the right to reject any and all bids, and waive any informalities in the bids received and to accept which bid it deems the most favorable.
- 11. PRE-BID SITE INSPECTIONS: The FHA shall conduct pre-bid site inspections on Thursday, October 8th, 2020 beginning at 10:00 am at the C.J. Durkin Apartments 50 Day Street. From there the FHA will conduct a site inspection for the other locations covered under this bid. This site inspection is not mandatory but the FHA cannot guarantee that it can provide the opportunity for other bidders to inspect the alarm systems covered in this bid.

- 12. BID QUESTIONS: All bid questions shall be submitted to Douglas M. Bushman, Executive Director of the FHA via email to the following two (2) addresses:

The RE in the email should state: QUESTIONS ALARM TESTING BID. Then the contractor in the body of the email shall state any question(s) they may have. Please note that if the FHA determines that the question has an impact concerning an interpretation of the bid documents then the question and response will be sent via an addendum to other identified bidders.

- 13. METHOD OF AWARD: The FHA shall select the most responsive and responsible bidder that meets or exceeds the requirements of the Request for Price Quote criteria at the lowest price on its bid form. Awards will be made based solely on the information provided by the bidder in the provided bid forms.
- pay all vendors within thirty (30) days of receiving an invoice but due to scheduling issues when the FHA Board of Commissioners meet to approve invoices the payment time period may extend to forty-five (45) calendar days from the submittal of a correct invoice after the Authority's receipt and acceptance of the services performed. (B) The FHA may require separate invoices based on the alarm systems location and/or housing program.

If the FHA's offices are closed on the day of the bid for any emergency then the bid opening will occur on the following business day that the FHA is open.

The FHA may see the need to issue addenda during this solicitation. Bidders known to the FHA will be notified using the established contact information supplied by the bidder

On the day of the bid opening the bids will be made available to those in attendance.

- 16. BID ACCEPTANCE PERIOD: The FHA shall have seventy-five (75) calendar days to make an award and execute the final contract, unless the time period is mutually waived by the parties.
- 17. **REQUIRED CONTRACT FORMS:** The successful bidder will be required to submit additional forms and documents after initial bid award but before a contract can be executed between the parties. These forms and documents include the following:
 - Proof of Liability Insurance Certificates (Listing FHA as additional insured)
 - Workers Compensation Certificate
 - W-9 Request for Taxpayer ID and Certificate

Other forms and documents may be required in addition to those listed above.

Information about Prevailing Wage Schedules for Awarding Authorities and Contractors

- This wage schedule applies only to the specific project referenced at the top of this page and uniquely identified by the "Wage Request Number" on all pages of this schedule.
- An Awarding Authority must request an updated wage schedule from the Department of Labor Standards ("DLS") if it has not opened bids or selected a contractor within 90 days of the date of issuance of the wage schedule. For CM AT RISK projects (bid pursuant to G.L. c.149A), the earlier of: (a) the execution date of the GMP Amendment, or (b) the bid for the first construction scope of work must be within 90-days of the wage schedule issuance date.
- The wage schedule shall be incorporated in any advertisement or call for bids for the project as required by M.G.L. c. 149, § 27. The wage schedule shall be made a part of the contract awarded for the project. The wage schedule must be posted in a conspicuous place at the work site for the life of the project in accordance with M.G.L. c. 149 § 27. The wages listed on the wage schedule must be paid to employees performing construction work on the project whether they are employed by the prime contractor, a filed sub-bidder, or any sub-contractor.
- All apprentices working on the project are required to be registered with the Massachusetts Department of Labor Standards, Division of Apprentice Standards (DLS/DAS). Apprentice must keep his/her apprentice identification card on his/her person during all work hours on the project. An apprentice registered with DAS may be paid the lower apprentice wage rate at the applicable step as provided on the prevailing wage schedule. Any apprentice not registered with DLS/DAS regardless of whether or not they are registered with any other federal, state, local, or private agency must be paid the journeyworker's rate for the trade.
- The wage rates will remain in effect for the duration of the project, except in the case of multi-year public construction projects. For construction projects lasting longer than one year, awarding authorities must request an updated wage schedule. Awarding authorities are required to request these updates no later than two weeks before the anniversary of the date the contract was executed by the awarding authority and the general contractor. For multi-year CM AT RISK projects, awarding authority must request an annual update no later than two weeks before the anniversary date, determined as the earlier of: (a) the execution date of the GMP Amendment, or (b) the execution date of the first amendment to permit procurement of construction services. Contractors are required to obtain the wage schedules from awarding authorities, and to pay no less than these rates to covered workers. The annual update requirement is not applicable to 27F "rental of equipment" contracts.
- Every contractor or subcontractor which performs construction work on the project is required to submit weekly payroll reports and a Statement of Compliance directly to the awarding authority by mail or email and keep them on file for three years. Each weekly payroll report must contain: the employee's name, address, occupational classification, hours worked, and wages paid. Do not submit weekly payroll reports to DLS. A sample of a payroll reporting form may be obtained at http://www.mass.gov/dols/pw.
- Contractors with questions about the wage rates or classifications included on the wage schedule have an affirmative obligation to inquire with DLS at (617) 626-6953.
- Employees not receiving the prevailing wage rate set forth on the wage schedule may report the violation to the Fair Labor Division of the office of the Attorney General at (617) 727-3465.
- Failure of a contractor or subcontractor to pay the prevailing wage rates listed on the wage schedule to all employees who perform construction work on the project is a violation of the law and subjects the contractor or subcontractor to civil and criminal penalties.
