## B. Executive Session

Motion to Enter into Executive Session per Massachusetts public law, pursuant to M.G.L. c. 30A, for two purposes: First per Chapter 31 §21(a)(2) and (3), to conduct a strategy session in preparation for negotiations with non-union personnel with respect to litigation. Second, per Chapter 31 §21(a)(6) to consider the purchase, exchange, lease or value of real property if the chair declares that an open meeting may have a detrimental effect on the negotiating position of the public body.

FOR INFO PURPOSES: Per Chapter 21(b) public body may meet in closed session provided that: 1. the body has first convened in an open session first and a majority members of the body voted to go into executive session and the vote of each member is recorded by roll call and entered into the minutes. Before entering into E.S., the chair shall state the purpose and subjects for entering into E.S. and the chair shall publicly announce whether the open session will reconvene at the conclusion of the executive session; and accurate records of the executive session shall be maintained.
