GENERAL INFORMATION REGARDING EXECUTIVE SESSIONS: Per Chapter 21(b) public body may meet in closed session provided that: 1. the body has first convened in an open session first and a majority member of the body voted to go into executive session and the vote of each member is recorded by roll call and entered into the minutes. 2. Before entering into E.S., the chair shall state the purpose and subjects for entering into E.S. and 3. the chair shall publicly announce whether the open session will reconvene at the conclusion of the executive session; and 4. accurate records of the executive session shall be maintained.
