The Executive Director thanked for 8 pallets of PPE donations on April 6, 2021 from MEMA (The Massachusetts Emergency Management Agency). The FHA plans on retaining some of the supplies for staff and distributing the rest to our tenants.

18. Vacancy & HAFIS Reports (Attachment J-Vacancy Report)

Andrew Skoog, Deputy Director updated that Vacancy rate for April 1st, increased from 33 units to 34 and the vacant unit days increased from 8,868 to 9,198. Excluding offline units, the vacant units' days drops to 1,130. Of the 34 vacancies, 3 are Ready to Occupy (RTO) units, 16 units are off-line for asbestos at Wallace Tower, 3 units are off-line for handicapped remodel at C. J. Durkin, 1 unit is offline for ADA accessibility project at Canton Valley, leaving only 11 units needing rehab.

19. DHCD-Tufts University CHAMP Study

The Deputy Director stated that Tufts University Graduate students had a study of CHAMP process requested by Andrew Clinton DHCD CHAMP specialist on April 20.

20. Security Camera

The Deputy Director explained that the FHA would have a 30-day trial of security camera system-Verkada for an interior and an exterior camera. If the FHA is satisfied with the system, the trial cameras and additional cameras can be purchased at a cost of approximately \$1300 each. We could replace the existing cameras in piecemeal as funding is available. Linda Byrne, the Chair suggested that it should be installed at trouble spots first.

The Executive Director explained that the meeting with DHCD to discuss the FHA's CIP was held on April 23, 2021. There seems to be confusion about the amount of funds that are allocated to the FHA. The confusion appears to stem from combining the normal annual award of Formula Funds with the various special awards that have been received in the last two years. If not allocated correctly it can throw off what a housing authority actually has to expend vs its set benchmark. (Attachment O)
