Restrictions: Referral required through the Department of Housing and Community Development (DHCD) or local Continuum of Care system.

Additional Support: The organization collaborates on food distribution initiatives and supports aging-in-place efforts via local partnerships.

Services: Short-term (3–6 months) transitional housing, education on navigating housing systems, and neighborhood support.

Eligibility: Families with children enrolled in Gardner Public Schools; parents must be working with regular income and have a clean CORI.

Restrictions: Limited capacity; application via soft referral from school care coordinators.

Friendly House

36 Wall Street Worcester, MA. 01604 (508) 755-4362 **Capacity:** 2 congregate shelters, 41 emergency apartments, 40 transitional apartments, and 32 supportive apartments (16 reserved for chronically homeless families).

Services: 24-hour staffing, case management, life skills classes, parenting support, housing search, and advocacy.

Eligibility: Families with children or expectant parents experiencing homelessness.

Restrictions: Applicants must qualify under the Massachusetts Emergency Assistance (EA) program.

Referral: Access is by referral through DHCD and the Continuum of Care process.

Eligibility: One- and two-parent families needing immediate shelter.

Restrictions: Open to one- and two-parent families. Must meet Massachusetts Emergency Assistance (EA) criteria. Referral through the Department of Housing and Community Development (DHCD) is required.

Referral: Families are referred by DHCD. Rental and stabilization support may follow.

In the Hour of Need Family Shelter

91 June Street Worcester, MA. 01602 (508) 755-2212 **Capacity:** Up to 6 families simultaneously in a large home.

Services: Private bedrooms, case management, employment assistance, and donated essentials from faith-based community.

Eligibility: Homeless families with children, regardless of income or structure.

Restrictions: Accepts families with children, regardless of income or family structure, including those not eligible for state EA shelters. All adults must pass a CORI check and sign a Code of Conduct acknowledgment.

Referral: Often coordinated via faith-network or self-referral; confirm current process.
